

LITTLE CABINS

Embroidery Pattern

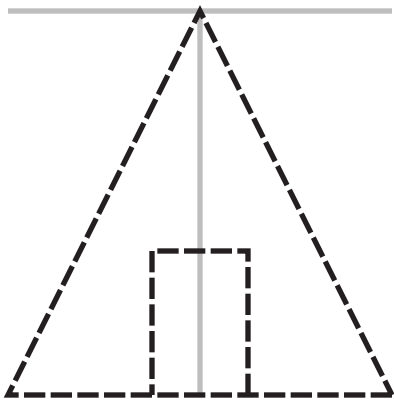


With this pattern, you can use embroidery to tack down the back pleat and give your Cabin a little something special. Use one of the cabin templates below, or create a one of a kind cabin by combining architectural elements or adding your own!

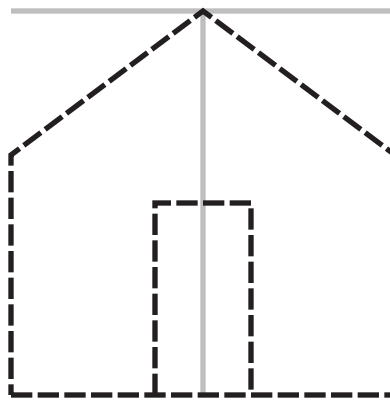
To mark the design on your garment:

1. Trace this pattern using an embroidery transfer pen. Follow the pen's instructions for ironing on your embroidery design once you have traced it.
2. Print out the pattern using a laser printer, or make a photocopy. Iron this print directly onto the fabric, face down. This works with variable results, so test on scrap fabric first!
3. Sandwich a piece of chalk transfer paper between the design and your fabric. Trace the design, leaving a chalk outline on your garment.

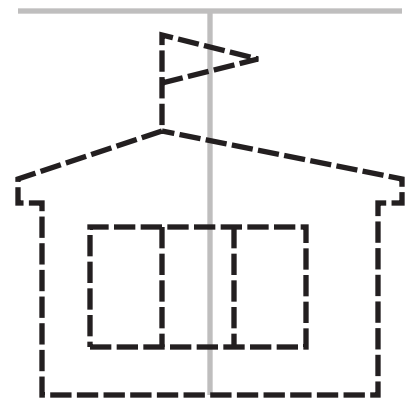
Note: When ironed on, the image will be reversed once transferred.



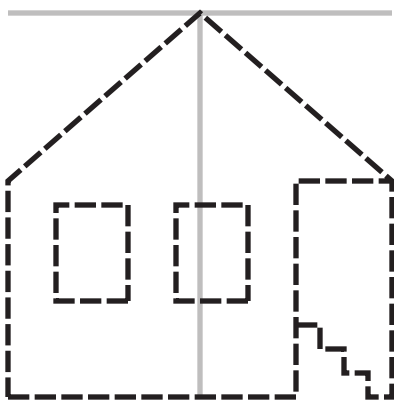
The A Frame



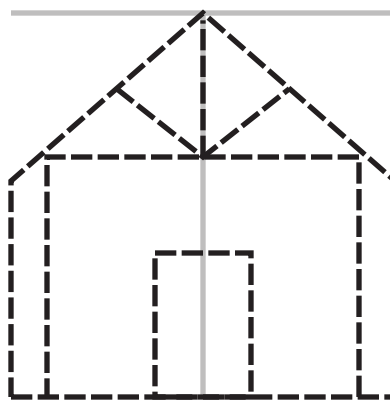
The Walden



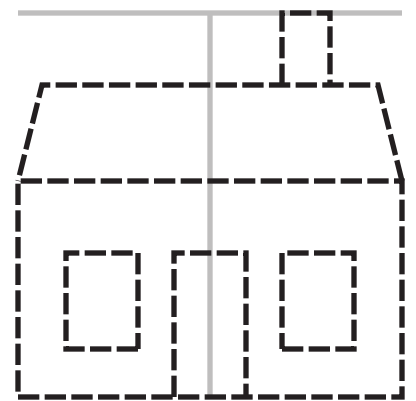
